Key and color in the three kingdoms that subdivided the empire after Alexander's death: Antigonas', Ptolemy's, and Seleucus'.

- 1. What tactic did Philip II, king of Macedon perfect in slaying northern invaders of Macedon?
- 2. What warning did Demosthenes give the Greek city states? What is significant about the conquering of the Greeks in the battle of Chaeronea? Add the Greek territories conquered by Philip II to the map above.
- 3. How did Alexander defeat the superior Persian army at Issus? Why was Alexander welcomed into Egypt? What is his legacy there?
- 4. At what city was the defeat of the Persians and Darius III complete?
- 5. Why did Alexander abandon his desire to conquer India? How did he die shortly after returning to Babylon?
