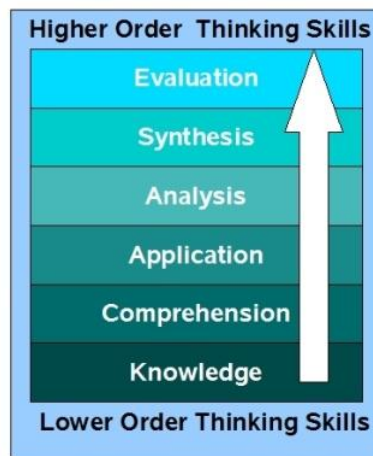


## BLOOM'S TAXONOMY OF CRITICAL THINKING: FOUNDATIONS OF ANCIENT GREECE

Bloom's Taxonomy is a hierarchy of Critical questions. It moves from simple identification of facts to the meaning of those facts, and finally use and evaluation of what those elements mean to us. The Hierarchy can be seen in the chart below:

- 1] **{COMPREHENSION}** How did the Greeks use the sea like the ancient Egyptians, Mesopotamians, Indus & Chinese used their great rivers? Provide several methods.
